ACTION ALERT from Florida Cultural Alliance [info@flca.net]

#1: The Governor does recommend \$5 million for Cultural and Museum Grants in his proposed budget. Please refer to budget line item 3118 in his proposed budget bill for FY 2015-2016. This is the amount he recommended last year as well.

Also, according to our Dr. Jim Zingale with Capitol Hill Group, there is \$1.5 billion in the Governor's proposed budget in non-recurring dollars that have not been allocated. It is critical that all arts and culture advocates please follow through on the Action Alert sent to you a couple of weeks ago. It will be the Florida Legislature that will recommend FY 2015-2016 appropriations for arts and cultural grants. They must hear from you NOW.
